Ceremony

Prelude:

This is the music played before the ceremony, typically chill, often instrumental, but it really can be anything that feels right to you.

Processional:

This is the music played while you and your wedding party walk down the aisle. You don't need a five-minute song. Most couples only hear 30–60 seconds. Think about how you want this moment to feel rather than worrying about finding the "perfect" song.

Signing:

This is the music played while you are signing the legal documents making everything official.

Recessional:

This the song played while you are walking back up the aisle as a married couple.

Introductions

What's your theme music? What do you like to strut into the room to? Would you like everyone in your wedding party to be introduced individually, or would you rather that everyone come in together?

Are you going to choreograph your dance? At minimum, I recommend that the two of you practice dancing to your song of choice.

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Special Dedication to Wedding Party: *This is almost always a slow song. If you don't have one in mind, I will recommend one. The reason why I do this, is so that when the party actually starts, the dance floor is already full.*

Special Song Requests: *What do you absolutely need to hear?*

Do Not Play List: *What do you absolutely not want to hear?*

Is anyone giving a speech?

Do those giving the speeches have theme music?

Those Little Extras

Does your wedding have a theme or does your wedding have a colour palette? For example, what are those in your wedding party wearing? I ask this so that I can appropriately coordinate what I'm wearing (I don't want to clash)

Where did the two of you meet?

What are some of your favourite styles of music? Can you name me 10 must play songs?

What are your least favourite styles of music?

What song was your parents' first dance? What song was your grandparents' first dance?

Do you have an Apple Music or Spotify playlist that makes the two of you dance? (Even if you don't have a playlist, sharing your profile with me is helpful)

What's your hype song?

Can you describe your vision of the music and entertainment for your wedding?

Overall, is it more important that the DJ executes your entire musical playlist or keeps guests dancing?





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How strict is your “do not play list”? (i.e. what would you like to do if/when a guest requests your least favourite song?)

What level of interaction do you seek from your wedding DJ?

Would you consider yourselves introverts or extroverts?

Tell me a little bit about your guests.
